


Learning Module Strategy Worksheet

- Orientation to Learning
 - A "heads-up" to the students
 - What are the objectives/outcomes?
 - What is expected of me?
 - What is the context? What do I already know? What do I want to know?



Learning Module Strategy Worksheet

- Module Content / Assessment
 - Readings, lectures, interviews, videos, multimedia
 - Interaction self-reflection, group work
 - Assessments practice, quizzes, dialogue




Learning Module Strategy Worksheet

- Summary and Close
 - Feedback What was learned? What needs more attention?
 - How does this relate to what's coming next?
 - What if I want to learn more?



Learning Module Strategy Worksheet

- File Formats
 - Microsoft Word may want to use Rich Text Format (RTF)
 - HTML/Webpage
 - PDF
 - PowerPoint
 - Audio
 - Video
